**Join an exciting new survey from Rosyth to Zeebrugge
on board Norfolkline's new ferry *Scottish Viking*

Research charity Marinelife started in 1995 with its successful Biscay Dolphin Research Programme and now operates monthly marine mammal and seabird surveys from five ports around the UK. The Rosyth to Zeebrugge route is the sixth survey and fills an important gap in the North Sea.

Volunteer surveyors are now being sought for this survey. Some previous experience of seabird and/or cetacean observation and identification is needed.

Marinelife is running a special shore-based introductory training event on Saturday 27th February 2010 at the Dell Farquharson Community Centre, Dunfermline, from 12:30 to 15:30h. Booking is essential and there is a nominal charge of £5 per person to help cover expenses, payable in advance.

The programme includes an introduction to ocean-going cetacean and seabird survey techniques and protocols, a brief overview of identification issues and guidelines on how to become more actively involved with Marinelife pelagic surveys.
